This world-class facility is housed in the historic Pennsylvania State Armory Building on Drexel University's campus in Philadelphia's burgeoning University City district. As the new home of US Squash, the 20-court facility also houses the US Squash Hall of Fame, a high-performance training center for Team USA athletes, the US Squash National Headquarters and a Learning and Innovation Center, through which US Squash has expanded an intensive out-of-school academic and mentoring program.

When early work on the project came to a standstill, over budget and without a viable construction schedule, Ned Edwards, President of US Squash, reached out to Dan Keating for advice.
