The project included a 40,000 square foot addition and renovations to the adjoining Towne Building and Graduate Research Wing, along with a variety of site utility and landscape improvements. Levine Hall provides laboratory, office and research space accommodating faculty expansion. It also houses the Computer and Information Science Department, the Robotics (GRASP) lab and a notable glass pavilion displaying student work.

The University engaged Keating Partners early in the program/planning phase of the project, specifically to address the complicated connection of new building to existing structures, address replacement of site utilities and to provide cost guidance in use of a European curtain wall system. This complicated addition and renovation was completed on schedule.
